Pre-Entry **\$15.00 per dog** – *PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE ON., May 15, 2017 at 8:00 PM CDST at home of Trial Secretary*
Day of Event **\$18.00 per dog** - Gate entries accepted until 1:00 PM CDST or until *LIMIT of 25 dogs is reached.*

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the American Kennel Club, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, and dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Phone, fax, and email entries will NOT be accepted.

Pre-Entries close at the trial Secretary's address **Wednesday, May 17, 2017 at 8:00 PM CDST**, unless the numerical limit (25 dogs) is reached prior to the date after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

MAKE ALL CHECKS/MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: BCOSW. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. Exhibitors whose checks are returned for NSF will be assessed a \$20.00 service fee. Entries will not be accepted if received without a signature and fees. An official American Kennel Club Entry Form must be used. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Attention Exhibitors

These trials may be canceled in the event of extreme weather conditions. No refunds will be given if the trial cannot be held or completed due to riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, extreme or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, or any other reason beyond the control of BCOSW.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made by email as soon as practical after the closing date. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary.

REFUNDS AND FEES: Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the trial-giving club it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Postdated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The trial-giving Club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check (\$20). Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Bitches in season will be refunded the entry fee less \$3.50 per run if requests are submitted to the Test Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the day and are accompanied by a veterinarian certification.

LIABILITY

BCOSW assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, their dogs or property, children or guests.

Neither the trial committees nor the trial-giving club will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the trial grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the trial is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises.

Exhibitors, Owners & Agents assume all responsibility for dogs & equipment on the show site.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Breed should be marked as "All American Dog."

ERRORS ON ENTRIES: Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions, or cancellations by the owner must be received in writing (email accepted) by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date of the trial. Other means of notification will not be accepted.

BCOSW reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.

Please keep the grounds clean by picking up after yourself and your dog. Dispose of 'poop' bags in the trash containers provided there. Please keep the trial site, grounds, and motel rooms and grounds clean so we may continue to be welcomed at these facilities.

VACCINATIONS: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

What IS A FAST CAT? The Fast CAT test is a timed 100-yard dash for dogs. Each dog runs alone. The dogs chase a furry lure with a squawker. The dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH (miles per hour).

A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0.
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0.

Points earned = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

Fast CAT titles suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:

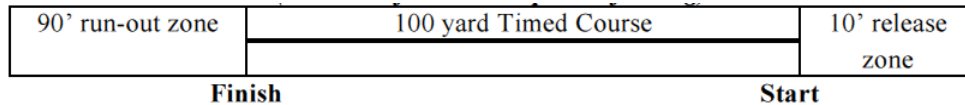
- BCAT = 150 points
- DCAT = 500 points
- FCAT = 1,000 points
- FCAT# = every additional 500 points

The dogs will run on a level, grassy racing lane. The lane will be fenced on both sides. There will be an approximate 90-foot run out space after the finish line into a fenced catch area.

TIMERS: Electronic timers

EXHIBITORS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO BRING A SECOND PERSON WHO IS KNOWN TO THEIR DOG(S) ALONG TO RELEASE THE DOG AT THE START, OR TO CATCH THE DOG AT THE END. The Basenji Club of Southeastern Wisconsin cannot guarantee that we will have extra club help to catch dogs at the end of the race.

COURSE MAP



General Information:

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test or trial.
2. Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period.
3. Each entry will be examined and measured (height at withers) at **inspection**. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded.
4. Run order will be based on order set by the field committee. We will separate the running of multiple dogs handled by a single handler. If a dog is late for their run time they will run at the end of the running order.
5. Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Owners should be aware that there is a chance that tags hanging from the collar could become entangled on something during the run. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.
6. A drag line lure machine will be used. The lure will be white plastic bags.
7. There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
8. No one will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
9. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
10. Control of dogs IS strictly enforced. They should be on leash at all times except when running.
11. Clean up and carry out all trash.
12. Please pick up after your dog and put in receptacles provided at site.
